City/Town	Effective	Description
Brooks, Alberta	January 2, 2002	Smoking prohibited in all public places where minors are permitted.
Calgary, Alberta	March 1, 2003 January 1, 2008	1. Restaurants to decide whether smoking or non-smoking establishments. 2. All remaining restaurants, lounges, bars, pubs and associated outdoor patios are to be smoke-free. Not including bingo halls as interim provisions for community associations will be established. ^{iv}
Camrose, Alberta	July 1, 2003	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted. ^v
Canmore, Alberta	January 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited in all public places where minors are permitted.
Cardston, Alberta	June 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places.
Claresholm, Alberta	July 1, 2003	Smoking in eating establishments where minors are allowed will be prohibited. ^{vi}
Coaldale, Alberta	May 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited where minors allowed.
Cochrane, Alberta	October 1, 2000	Smoking prohibited in all public food establishments where minors are allowed.
Cold Lake, Alberta	January 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited where a restaurant is not a licensed beverage room.
Edmonton, Alberta	May 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 July 1, 2005	1. All restaurants not restricted to minors 18 and under 2. All restaurants that are not Class A/B licensing. (Gaming and liquor only establishments.) 3. All lounges, bars and pubs, bingo halls and associated outdoor patios. ⁱⁱ
Fort McMurray, Alberta	November 29, 2004	Smoking prohibited where minors allowed, except for the purpose of minors volunteering in Bingo halls.
Grande Prairie, Alberta	January 1, 2003	Smoking prohibited where minors allowed.
Lethbridge, Alberta	January 1, 2000	All restaurants not restricted to minors 18 and under.
Magrath, Alberta	January 1, 2000	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted.
Medicine Hat, Alberta	July 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited where minors allowed.
Olds, Alberta	January 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted.
Pincher Creek, Alberta	January 1, 2000	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted.
Red Deer, Alberta	September 17, 2002	No smoking in a public indoor place where minors are allowed.
Taber, Alberta	July 1, 2000	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted.
Three Hills, Alberta	January 1, 2002	Smoking prohibited in all enclosed public places where minors are permitted.
Strathcona County, Alberta	January 1, 2003 June 1, 2005 (2-phase plan)	1. Smoking prohibited where minors are allowed. 2. All lounges, bars and pubs, bingo halls and associated outdoor patios. ⁱⁱⁱ
Wood Buffalo (region), Alberta	November 29, 2004	Smoking prohibited where minors allowed, except for the purpose of minors volunteering in Bingo halls.
